It was moved, seconded, and passed that the Minutes of May 14, 2025 be approved.

WHOLE CHURCH BUSINESS

A mission group from the Evansville, Indiana United Methodist Church stayed in the Church this summer. Their mission was to help wherever possible which included a lot of work at the parsonage and during the Fourth of July Celebration. They were in attendance in church on Sunday.

SUMMER ACTIVITIES

FINANCE

Budget is going well. A general fund quarterly offering progress report is available in the Fellowship Hall and in the office.

Pastor was added to the 1st Bank account as a signer. There have been a few requests for assistance. Susan Schmidtberger is a new member of the group.

MEMBERSHIP

Continuing to send cards to members and continuing to give welcome packets to visitors. We welcomed 1 new member, Lynette Link. Welcome to our church family Lynette.

- SAFETY The AED that has been beeping is now fixed. A reminder that we have an AED in the Fellowship Hall and several first aid kits around the church. First aid training will be held and Suzanne Palmer will teach the classes.
- SPR Pastor came on board and is settling in well! He has officiated 3 funerals starting day 1.

 On boarding sessions begin tomorrow involving staff in the morning and laity leaders in the evening. These will be conducted by Calley Welborn.

The visitation list has been updated for pastoral care. The staff is good. We will be reaching out to the congregation, Cody and Powell newspapers, Northwest College Music Department, and possibly social media to hire an assistant Music Director starting in the fall through May, as Kennedy will be in school in Laramie

TRUSTEES

We have a few things to complete. These include removal of tree stumps at the parsonage, regrade the grassy area on the west side of the church to prevent leakage from the sprinklers, and replace gutters on the north side of the church.

UWF Carry-in in the park was successful.

Next meeting is in September.

WORSHIP

Discussed all the functions of the Worship Committee. Delineated who is responsible for all those duties. Pastor Alex will keep the service and content as they are for now. Blessing of the animals possibly in September Pastor Alex will be out of town November 2nd. He will work with SPR to fill the pulpit that Sunday. All Saints Day will be moved to a different day so that Pastor Alex can officiate that service which recognizes those who have passed away in our congregation this year. The new candles in the sanctuary seem to be working well so there is no reason to purchase others.

Laity Sunday will be the third Sunday in October. Plans are being made for that service. The committee hopes to include as many lay members as possible. Ad Council will be meeting monthly starting in September.

PASTORS REPORT

Pastor Alex has been here for 6 weeks. Things are going well. Listening groups were successful. Between 3 and 13 parishioners attended and another session is being planned for sometime this fall. On-boarding sessions went well. Pastor Alex's current focus is visitations including phone calls and future focus is congregational care. The current worship subject for 4 weeks is faith. An open house at the parsonage is being planned. No date has been set. Pastor's office hours are 9-1, Monday through Thursday. Youth Group with Christ Episcopal and Trinity Lutheran Churches will start in September. Dates that Pastor will be gone include Sept 24-26 for Clergy Orders, Oct 17-19 for District Gathering, Oct 31-Nov 3 for a wedding in Texas. Closing Prayer – Pastor Alex





